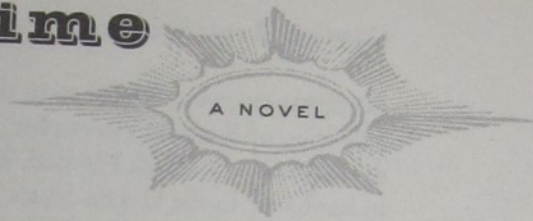
For all you members who enjoyed The Devil All The Time (TDATT) movie shoot...

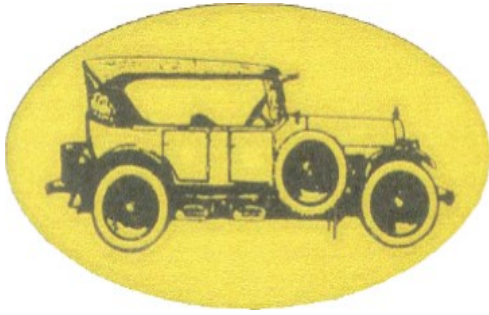
We want to find a buyer for it, as is. Hoping to get at least \$10K for it. I appreciate any suggestions you have, and any information you can share with contacts who might be interested.
