We encourage each of our members to own and wear a Dixie Vintage Car Club name tag. We really do want to get to know you. The cost of the name tag is \$10.00.

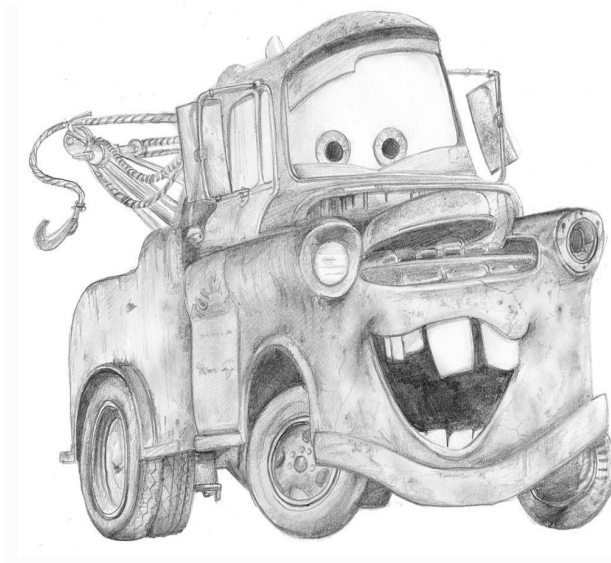

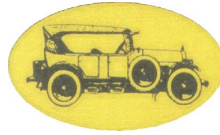


The truck pictured above is happy that many Dixie Vintage members showed up at February's Hoover Tac's 1st Saturday morning show.

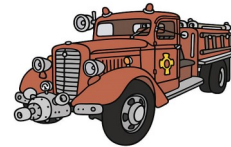
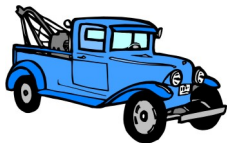

At Blakely's Service station in Arizona the cost of a gallon appears to be 18 cents.

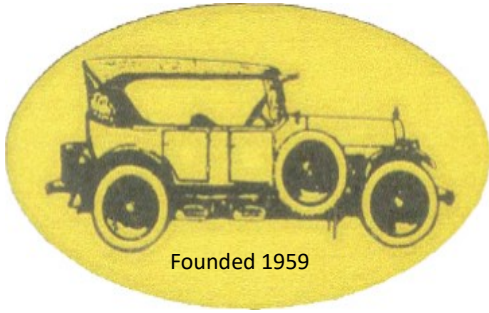


Member's request

The best selling car in 1962 was the Lincoln Continental. Offering 300 horsepower in a 430 cubic inch engine the car weighed 4930 pounds. Body styles included a four-door sedan or a four-door convertible. It sold for \$6,750. By comparison a new Cadillac sold for \$5,080. 31,061 Continentals were made for the 1962 model year. This car can be purchased today in the price range of \$6,000 to about \$45,000.
